



Feel bass clarinet is the event where clarinetists share their enthusiasm and knowledge of the clarinet. On Saturday the 3rd of July clarinetists of all ages and grades can play together in ensembles, in a clarinet choir or can take part in a workshop. All workshops take place at the same time, therefore it's not possible to take part in more than one workshop.

On Friday there will be a concert by Paolo de Gaspari and Alessandro Pivetti, in the evening there is a Jazz café (Alessandro Pivetti, József Balogh, Michel Duijvens and John de Beer)

On Sunday two Clarinetchoirs will join together. Rehearsal will be led by John de Beer. In the afternoon there is the final concert. Clarinetorchestra Capriccio will play together with Matthias Müller and József Balogh, then the Koninklijke Harmonie Heerlen will play together with Paolo de Gaspari.

Workshop Improvising

How to lose the sheet music and create your own music, is what you will learn in this workshop. Participants hand in sheet music of a song from jazz, pop or classical music (voorafgaand) to the workshop. The teacher will choose three songs out of these, which will guide the students with learning how to improvise during these songs.
